

This shrub is a member of the pea family. With its showy, fragrant flowers, it is also native to much of North America. It can form dense thickets and has a deciduous growing habit, where leaves disappear at the end of the season. In addition to this, it is a larval host to several butterfly species, including the silver-spotted skipper and the gray hairstreak.
