




Butterfly Weed

Asclepias tuberosa



If you want to support Monarch Butterfly migrations, plant this brilliant orange flower. It is a nectar source for butterflies, including the migratory Monarch. Butterfly weed is one of the most stunning wildflowers available for garden culture. Radiant clusters of small florets naturally vary from light to dark oranges and turn into ornamental seedpods for added garden interest. This native should not be confused with Mexican milkweed- a potential invasive species.

- Perennial
- Grows 1-2 feet upright
- Found in dry uplands, forest edges
