A unique ornamental, the Buttonbush is a shrub that's known for its flowers. Flowers are balls of white, similar to pincushions, and fruit is button-like. While this plant prefers constantly moist soil, it can take standing water and poor drainage. Ducks and other birds eat the seeds. This plant is also attractive to butterflies, sphinx moths, and bees.

- Perennial - Grows 6-12 feet - Found in swamps, pond/stream edges
