

Rabbit bells Crotalaria rotundifolia



A member of the pea family this species grows as a ground cover. Yellow flowers are produced from late spring to fall. An added bonus is seed pods that sound like a baby rattle when shaken.

- Perennial - Grows 6-12 inches - Found in flatwoods, sandhills, dry pine woodlands.
