Gaillardia pulchella



A popular choice, Indian blanket is a splash of red and yellow. It likes it dry, but can take moist soil. This plant can be a perennial in warm, coastal areas. Blooming can also go on past the summer if given adequate water. It reseeds readily, with fall seedlings able to grow taproots before frost hits.

- Annual/Perennial - Grows 2 feet - Found in dry plains, prairies, meadows
