

Comfortroot Hibiscus aculeatus



Flowers are 2-4 inches wide, cream colored with dark red centers. Petals often have scalloped edges. Leaves have a rough texture like a cat's tongue. This plant has a lifespan of around 6 years and should be cut back to the ground in winter to allow for spring growth. A wetland plant, this species likes it moist and can grow in sandy soil with regular irrigation.

- Perennial - Grows 3-6 feet - Found in wet pinelands and roadsides
