



St. John's Wort

Hypericum sp.



Shrub-like, this genus blooms mid-summer and sometimes into autumn. Flowers are bright yellow and can be four petaled or five. Berries are often nondescript. Plants often take pruning well, and even grow better. Mound-growing and semi-woody, plants make good groundcover candidates. Moisture varies, but most like consistently moist soils.

- Perennial
- Grows 1-2 ft
- Found in wet meadows, prairies
