



Lady Lupine

Lupinus villosus



Lavender-blue flowers appear with large, red-purple spots on upper lips. Stems grow up to 2 feet high and flowering begins at the bottom. Leaves are hairy. Plants grow in well drained areas that are sandy, such as sandhills. Most plants live about 3 years, so seed collection in the second and third years is essential. Toxic if ingested.

- Perennial
- Grows 2 feet
- Found in sandhills, scrub, upland forests
