



# American Wisteria

*Wisteria frutescens*



Attractive swathes of lavender flowers draw the eye with this plant. It takes plants 5 years to bloom from seed, but when they do . . . watch out! This native deciduous vine is not invasive like its Asian cousin. Leaves are a glossy, shiny green. Unlike the invasive varieties, this native is much easier to control, and as an added benefit, attracts our native butterflies. Seed pods are 2-4 inches long and dark. Toxic.

- Perennial - Grows 30 feet - Found in moist woods
