research vessel. Based at the Brunswick Station, the “Bulldog,” as she is more commonly referred to, was originally named the Lady Marilyn, and was built in 1977 in St. Augustine, Florida, by the Diesel Engine Sales Company (DESCO).

The trip will travel out into the estuaries and ocean waters. The nets will be lowered and various sea life will be pulled on board for identification. You will get to see what truly lives in the waters around us. You should leave with a better appreciation for the bounty of life that calls the Georgia coast home.
